### DOSAGE AND CONDITIONS OF USE

**SGRASSATORE** is diluted in cold water in a ratio from 1: 1 to 1:80 depending on the surfaces to be treated and the type of contamination to be removed.

Allow the product to act for a few seconds on the surface where it has been sprayed, and then move on with a clean cloth, suede or just moistened sponge and cleaned well.
